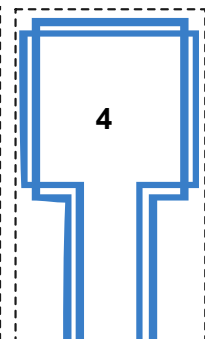

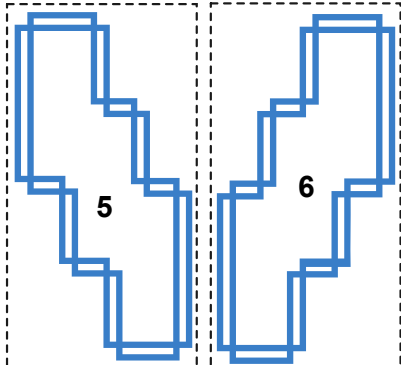

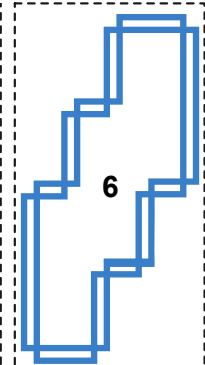


Lower and Upper aligned top. Use alternate lower case

This font contains 6 different frames assigned to numbers 1-6 and 3 different sets of lower case letters depending on the look you want to achieve

**EXAMPLE** Start a New Text item, in the text box HOLD down the ALT key on the keyboard, and with the NUMPAD on the right, type in the 4 digit number, release the ALT key and the ALT character will appear

For Large letters use upper case

For small letters aligned in middle top to bottom use lower case

For small letters aligned on top use table 1

For Small letters aligned on Bottom use table 2

**Letter Spacing is automatic on this font. You must use a Letter space of 0 to assure correct placement in the frame. AUTOKERNING must be OFF with this font**
